# Pictures

- Do a Google search
- Choose pictures that are clear and simple
- Click on the image you want to use and view it in full size
- Click copy and then paste it on your power-point slide
- Write down the source of the picture – give credit to the original source

# To Add Links

- Highlight the word you want to use to connect to another site
- Right click on it, and go down to Hyperlink
- Click on the little world with magnifying glass
- Search for and find the site you want to use
- When it is open, go back to your power-point – the site will be written in the insert hyperlink box.
- Click ok
- That's it!
